1. Granting of this application will mean that Wyndham residents will have no further say in any decision making regarding the Landfill . It is unfair to shut out the community who will be impacted by this for not only the life of the landfill but into the future. It also creates a precedent for shutting out the community in decision making.

There are only excuse as to why nothing has been done. How can Council get away with this and will this continue in the future if they are granted this permit?
- 4. The management of leachate, gas and odour will only become more difficult with the expansion and this will have an impact on residents. There have already been issues .
- 5. Granting of this approval will not provide any incentive for industry and the community to reduce waste or find alternative ways of reuse and recycling.
- 6. Aboveground tips are an unacceptable way of disposing of waste putting a burden on the residents who live nearby. There are alternatives but why would they be looked at if Council had a guaranteed source of income for the next 30+ years. This is not the way forward but a step back. Its up to the EPA to be a leader into the future, to steer industry into looking for better ways of reducing, recycling and converting waste to energy.
